Dear Scoutmaster,

If you are not affiliated with this Webelos Pack, Troop, Explorer Post or Venture Crew any longer, please pass this notice on to the new unit leader or unit. Thank you.

The Department Family Scouting Committee is sponsoring the American Legion Family Scouting Camporee on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, **June 16th-18th, 2023.**

REGISTRATION: **Due by April 30th.** Late Registrations will be charged a LATE FEE.

PLACE: Camp Collier, Gardner, Massachusetts

FEE (includes patch): **\$20 per Scout, \$20 per Adult/guest/sibling, if paid by April 30th**

**LATE FEE of \$35 per unit if unit has not registered by April 30th, \$50 per unit if not paid by June 14th.**

Friday evening and early Saturday morning are for setting up camp. Activities to be announced, and church services will be arranged. New patches will be presented to each scout signifying his participation in the Camporee. Enclosed is a Registration form. Checks are to be made payable to the:

**Department of Massachusetts, The American Legion** and marked "Scout Camporee" and mailed to the address below, or either **PAYPAL** or **VENMO** may be used. Directions on the registration form.

FULL PARTICIPATION OF ALL LEGION SPONSORED/CO-SPONSORED UNITS TO THIS CAMPOREE IS REQUESTED. The Camporee is open to all affiliated Webelos Dens as a Father and Scout weekend, and all (Webelos) Packs, Troops, Explorers and Venture units. **(Please consider bringing the whole family!)**

The Camporee will consist of outdoor living (bring your own tents), campsite cooking on your own charcoal stoves (each patrol will have their own food) outdoor skills, campsite inspection and all Scout skills. It is advisable for all troops to bring their own materials for their gateways and gallon plastic jugs for drinking water.

The highlight will be Sunday morning, 09:00 when the awards and ribbons will be presented to the winners of the various events. The overall winner will receive a rosette ribbon.
